# 1. 2017 Financial Review:

- Balance Sheet \$171,000+ balance
- Net Income \$10,590
- Accounting Fees up by \$2000 from previous year
- Expense for engineering review for roads
- Expenses in general were down from previous year
- More in legal fees in 2017 due to potential lawsuit of manufactured shed
- Lawn Maintenance down \$3600

# 2. Volunteer Accomplishments

- Sprinkler repairs
- Updated Homeowners contact list, web page
- Bridle Trail clearing
- Beautification of front entrance

# 3. 2018 Priorities

# Maintenance of community assets (repair/restoration)

- 5-6 year roads residual life span anticipated
- Storm water drainage system renovation
- Bridle Trail need Lot 7 easement to eliminate dead-end or leave as is
- Further maintenance of Bridle Path depending on gaining of easement
  - Beautification (entrance)
    - o Bid received to replant injured plants & replace mulch with live ground cover

- o Remove palm trees & replace with sabal palms or other trees
- Oak tree trimming
- Roadway-facing horse fencing repair/upkeep (homeowners responsibility)
  - Unofficial communication encouraging repair of missing, broken, sagging fencing
  - o Will send violation notices if improvements not made
  - Need association feedback on mandating repainting/refinishing
    - Discussion among meeting attendees occurred no need to refinish as natural wood is permitted
- Maintenance of web site and communication process
  - o Identify a replacement for Patti Couture or contract Patti
  - o Assign Communication process to another board member

### 4. Pavement LifeCycle Cost Analysis Update

- Reason for \$100 increase in HOA annual dues
- Two contractors consulted: Ajax and Superior
- Estimate of 5-6 years remaining life span
- \$170,000 \$200,000+ estimate

#### 5. Bridle Trail Update

- Successful Bridle Trail Neighborhood Work Day 10/7/2017
- 25 neighbors contributed
- Reviewed trail issues related to wetlands and easements that will be required
- Discussion among meeting attendees occurred
- In order to make the trail usable, any "dead ends" must be eliminated or alternate paths must be available

## 6. Storm Water Drainage System Update

- Several civil contractors and civil engineering firms were contacted for quotes
- Contracted with George F. Young, Inc. Engineering on 3/12/2018
  - They will provide on-site inspection of existing culverts
  - $\circ$   $\;$  They will prepare Construction Plan documents of work required
  - o They will present their findings and documents to HOA Board at meeting
  - They will assist in review of bids and aid in award of contract of work and discuss with county officials if permits required
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Site observation during construction and letter of release for completion of work
  - It will cost \$3275 for their services

- Contractor will perform site inspection soon
