7. 2020, 2021 & 2022 YTD Accomplishments / Highlights

- o Bridle Trail Clearing (Flottemesch easement opens new trail; Bill Zinn now mowing)
- o Swales and Drainage Project completed including CMP replacement
- Road repairs & repaving
 - Future costing depending on cost of resources (oil, labor, etc.)
 - \$60K for High Oaks Trail (today's dollars)
 - \$95K for balance of Saddlebag Trail (today's dollars)
 - 5- to 7-year life expectancy for current 'old' roads (@ today's usage)
 - Barring unanticipated major expenses, potential to keep dues @ \$600/yr
- Entrance bed replanting & sprinkler maintenance (ongoing)
 - Thanks to Tom, Tim, Jim!
- Medieval Fair concern engagement (\$5,000 legal fees)
- Community yard sale 3/5/2022
 - Many thanks to Rose Riggle
- o FDOT SR70 double-line repainted
